SCOPE OF RELIANCE (ABSOLUTE)

This document exclusively governs:

- (a) qualification of misuse;
- (b) consequences for licence and usage rights;
- (c) corrective communication by *Go Secure*.

The document does not create an advisory relationship,  
no monitoring obligation, no investigation obligation  
and no monitoring obligation.

## 1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this document is to establish a unambiguous, enforceable and licence-bound framework for identifying, correcting and terminating misleading, unauthorised or unlicensed use of Go Secure documentation and facilities.

## 2. DEFINITION OF MISUSE

Misuse shall *include, but not be limited to* the following

- whether direct, indirect, partial or derivative;
- use within Formal context without active Pro licence;
- use with integrity artefacts removed, modified or disconnected;
- distribution, resupply or making available to third parties or group companies without written consent;
- presentation or framing as advice, opinion, assurance formal validation or decision;
- suggesting or implying monitoring, oversight or audit by Go Secure;
- public publication or publicly accessible disclosure, regardless of medium or channel.

## 3. NO MONITORING - NO INVESTIGATION - YES ENFORCEMENT

Go Secure does not monitor actual use and does not conduct any structural or ad hoc investigations into usage by the Customer.

Enforcement does not imply knowledge of actual usage and can only follow from:

- reporting by third parties;
- signals from the Customer himself; or
  - objectively established circumstances afterwards, without creating an obligation to investigate.

## 4. CONSEQUENCES OF ABUSE

In the event of (suspected) abuse, Go Secure shall be entitled to, without prior notice of default:

- immediately suspend user rights;
- withdraw access to releases or facilities;
- terminate the Pro Licence in case of material breach;

- take protective measures to protect of intellectual property and contractual position.

## 5. CORRECTIVE NOTICE

5.1 Go Secure may issue a written Corrective Notice stating exclusively:

- which use qualifies as misuse under the Pro Framework;
- which representation or application is incorrect or misleading;
- which remedial measures are required.

5.2 A Corrective Notice:

- Does *not* constitute a determination of civil, criminal or administrative liability;
- relates solely to a qualification within the licence and terms of use;
- does not create any rights for third parties.

## 6. REMEDIAL MEASURES

Go Secure may require the Customer to:

- cease misleading claims, expressions or representations;
- withdraw files from Formal context;
- terminates external dissemination;
- corrects recipients to the extent necessary to eliminate deception or misrepresentation.

## 7. NO THIRD PARTY RIGHTS

Third parties derive no rights from this document or from Corrective Notices of Go Secure.
